##### 4. Type of Allocation of Quota Places

The quota place(s) is/are allocated to the NOCs

#### ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force, including but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors). Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Winter Youth Olympic Games.

##### Age Requirements:

To be eligible to participate in the 2016 Lillehammer Winter Youth Olympic Games, all athletes must be born between 01 January 1998 and 31 December 1999.

### C. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

Due to the combined qualification system, World Cup Nation Cup Score together with Nation Cup Points scored at the last two (2) Youth/Junior World Championships (refer to IBU Event and Competition Rules art.15.8 World Cup Scoring System); all continents where biathlon is represented have the chance to participate in the YOG.

#### QUALIFICATION PLACES

The events are listed in hierarchical order of qualification.

##### D1 Individual Qualification

<u>D1.1:</u> 30 men 30 women	<u>D1</u>	<u>Place 1 – 20</u>
	D1.1	The top 15 NOCs in each gender from the 2014/2015 season's World Cup Nation Cup Score will receive two (2) quota places per gender.
<u>D1.2:</u> 10 men 10 women	D1.2	The top 5 ranked NOCs based on the sum of the Nation's Cup Points from the previous two (2) seasons YJWCHs (scoring the points of up to 2 youth and 2 junior athletes) who have not already qualified from D1.1 will receive two (2) quota places per gender.
		<u>Places 21 – 29</u>
<u>D1.3</u> 9 men 9 women	D1.3	The next nine (9) best ranked NOCs based on the sum of the Nations Cup Points from the previous two (2) seasons YJWCHs (scoring the points of up to 2 youth and 2 junior athletes) who have not qualified through D1.1 or D1.2 will earn a total of two (2) quota places; one (1) per gender.

##### D2 Mixed Relay

Qualification Event	
D2.1	The Biathlon Mixed Relay competition shall consist of two (2) women and two (2) men from the same NOC. Only NOCs from D1 in the List of Qualified NOCs will automatically qualify a Mixed Relay team.

##### D3 Super Sprint Mixed Relay

Qualification Event	
D3.1	The Biathlon Single Mixed Relay competition shall consist of one (1) man and one (1) woman from the same NOC. NOCs which have qualified at least one (1) man and one (1) woman will automatically qualify a Single Mixed-Relay team.

#### HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Should the Host Country not qualify any athletes through the Nations Cup Score it is guaranteed one (1) quota place per gender.

The Host Country has the right to enter one (1) Team in both Relays.

If the Host Country is ranked from place 21 and below, it can register an additional one (1) man and one (1) woman for Biathlon Mixed Relay only (additional athletes cannot be entered or replace original registered athletes at other competitions).

### D. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

IBU shall inform the NOCs of their allocated quota places on (date). The NOCs will then have one (1) week to confirm if they wish to use these quota places, as described in section **G. Qualification Timeline**.

### E. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

#### REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION PLACES

Unused qualification places will be reallocated in the following order, as described in section **D. Qualification Pathway** above:

- If a quota place allocated to the NOC from Top 15 NOCs from previous season's World Cup Nation Cup Score (2014/15) is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next best ranked NOC not yet qualified from the previous season's World Cup Nation Cup Score (2014/15).
- If a quota place allocated to the 14 NOCs based on the sum of Nation's Cup Points from the two previous season's YJWCHs (Presque Isle 2014 and Minsk 2015) is not confirmed by the NOC by the confirmation of quota place deadline or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to next best ranked NOC not yet qualified in rank order based on the sum of Nation's Cup Points from the two previous season's YJWCHs (Presque Isle 2014 and Minsk 2015).

#### REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Should the Host Country qualify through the above qualification process, any unused Host Country places will be reallocated to the NOC ranked 30th in the Nation Cup Ranking.
